Johan Malmsten is an experienced consultant and facilitator, having spent over ten years supporting clients ranging from independent entrepreneurs to Fortune 500 companies. He is a relationship manager and consultant with the Oxford Leadership Academy, chiefly responsible for European clients and Fellows.

He is also active as founder of TWVC (Third World Venture Capital), a nonprofit organisation supporting entrepreneurship in the developing world, and Europe Today, a European newspaper project.

Johan started his professional career early in life as an independent consultant.
